

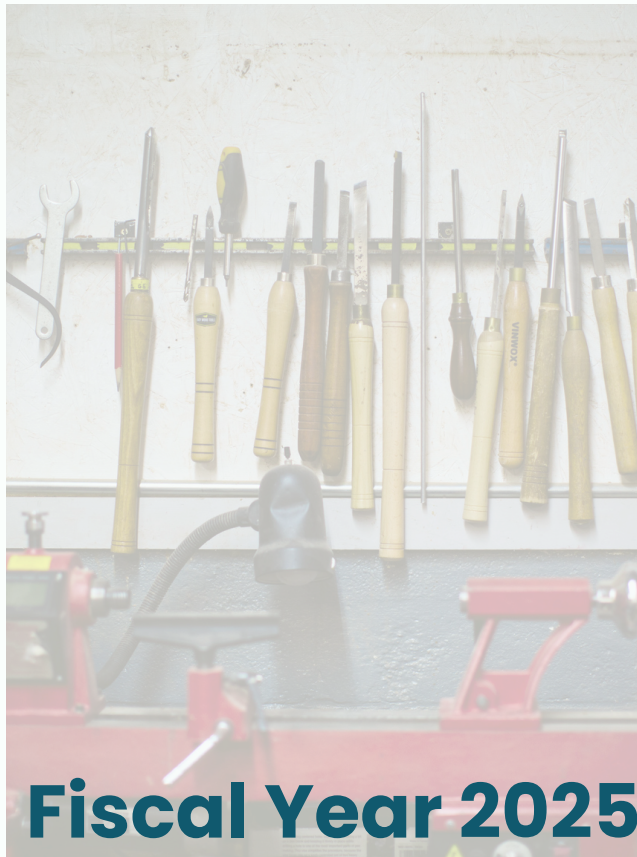

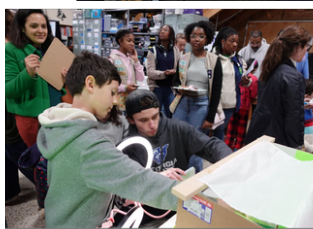

Making a Difference Together

Our passion for making extends beyond our makerspace. We believe in the transformative power of creativity, collaboration, and community engagement. In every project we undertake, we strive to make a meaningful impact not only within our organization but also in the broader community we call home.

Community Nature Kitchen

In partnership with Compassionate Atlanta, Decatur Makers built a Nature Kitchen play area at Waller's Coffee Shop. Using recycled and natural materials, the space encourages kids to explore, imagine, and connect through sensory play—offering families a creative, restorative place to gather and grow together.



Back-to-School Community Drive

Decatur Makers hosted a School Supply Drive for City Schools of Decatur, collecting over 70 backpacks and hundreds of essential supplies.

This community effort helped ensure local students began the school year ready to learn, reflecting our shared belief that access and opportunity start with support.

Welding Workshop with Shepherd Center

Decatur Makers partnered with the Shepherd Center to host a welding workshop that empowered participants through hands-on creativity and skill-building. The experience fostered confidence, connection, and a sense of accomplishment—showing how accessible making can support both recovery and community.



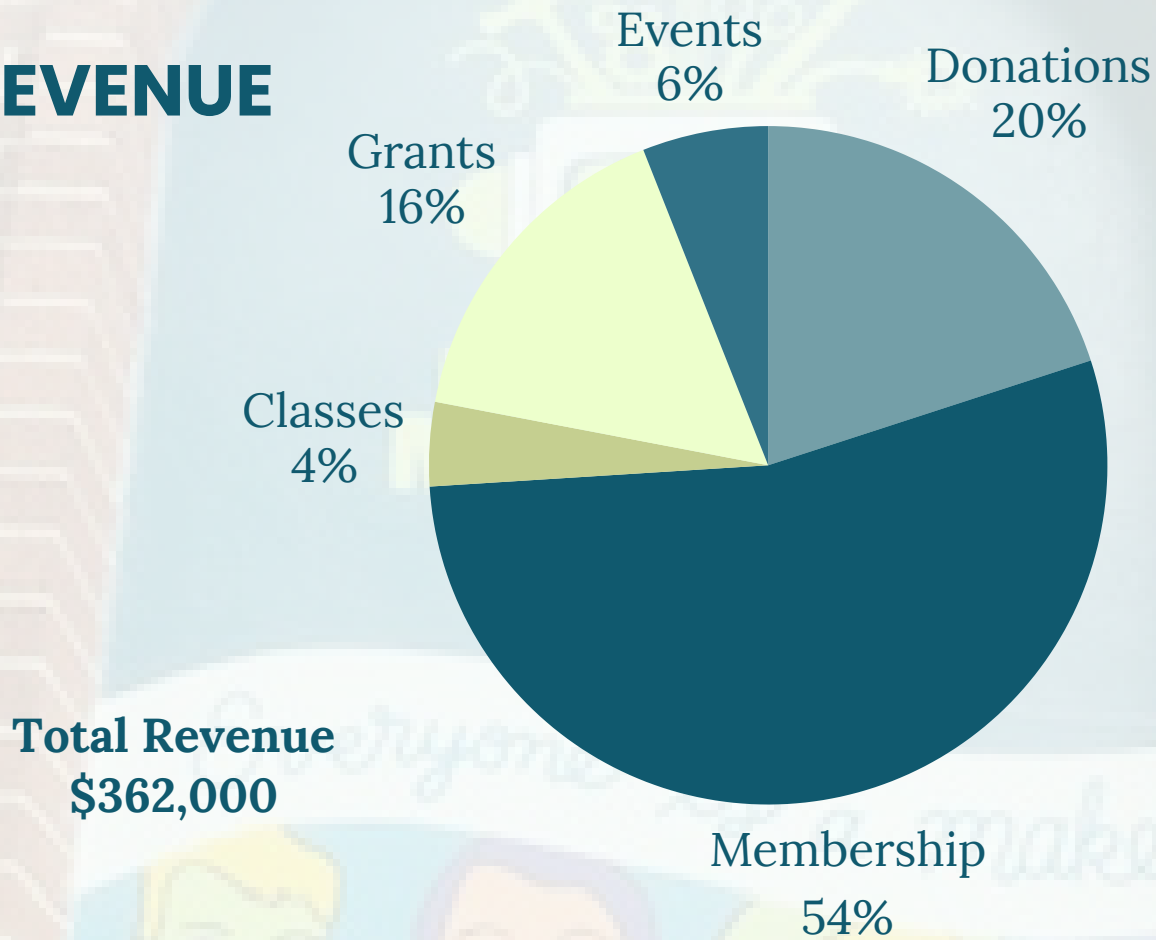
Garden Stakes Project

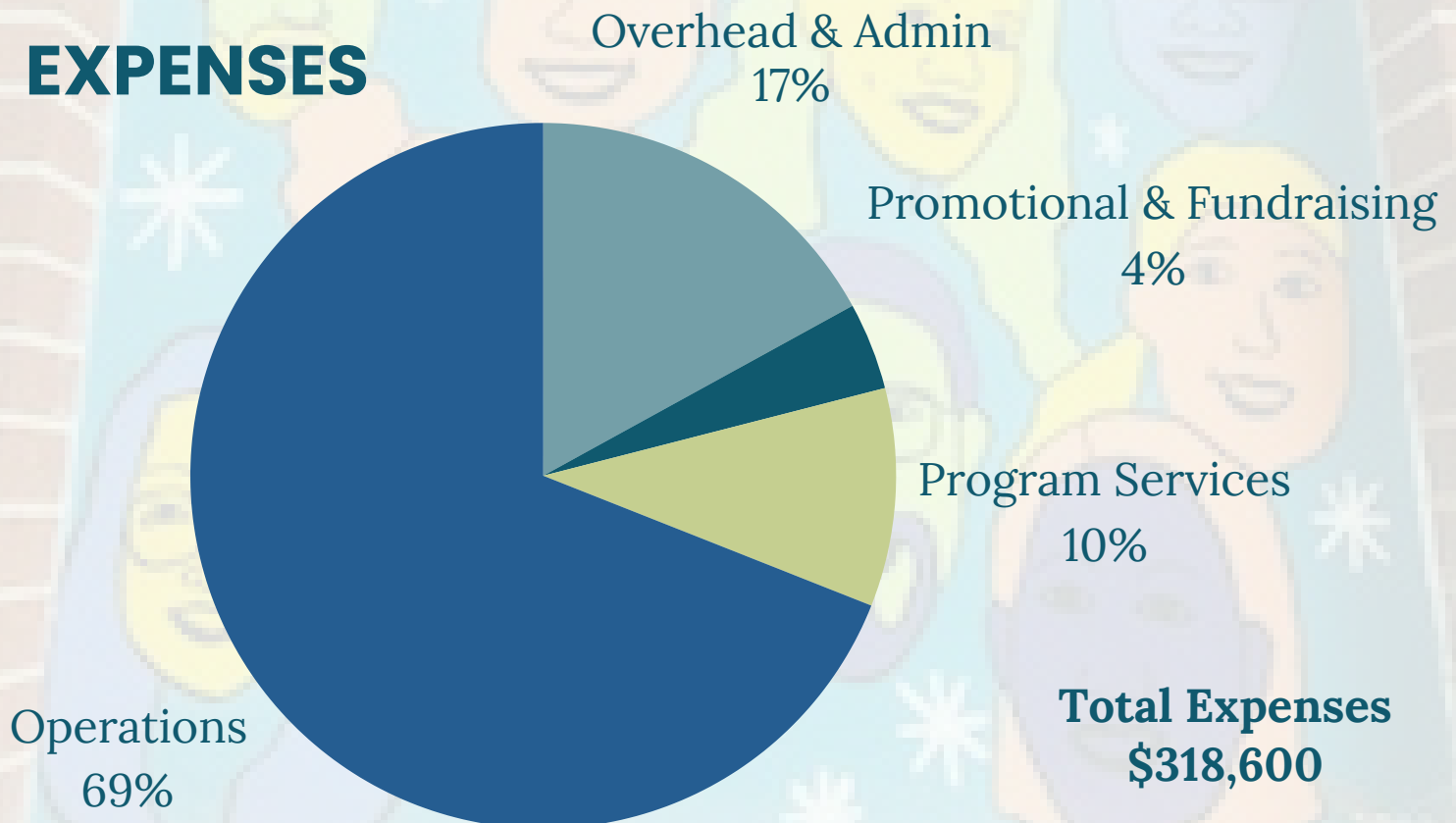
